

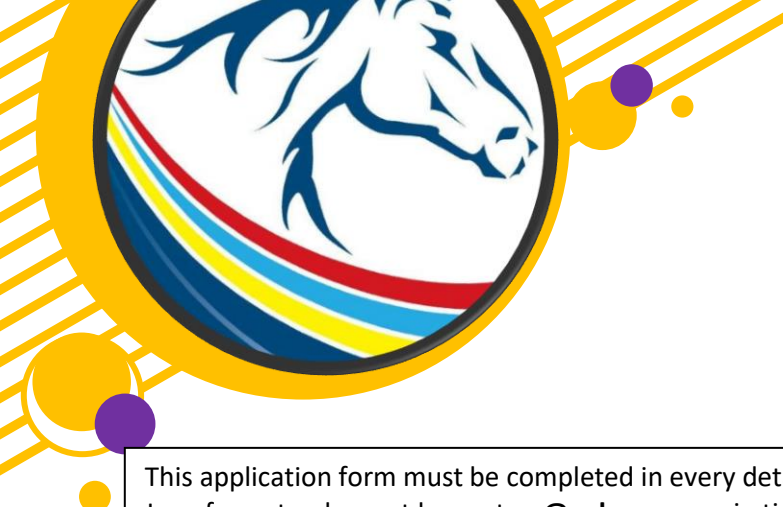

YOUTH WORLD CUP 2020 APPLICANT AGREEMENT

Please consider my application for: RIDER () LEADERSHIP () or BOTH ()

I, _____ (full name) in applying for consideration for selection as a riding, reserve or leadership team member of Team Australia for Youth World Cup 2020 to be held in the Netherlands.

1. Abide by any and all rules of the Australian Quarter Horse Association.
2. Abide by any and all rules of the American Quarter Horse Association.
3. Abide by any and all rules relating to Team Australia, as determined by the AQHA and Team Management.
4. Be governed and supervised by the Team Manager and Team Coach of Team Australia during my travel to, participation in, and travel from Youth World Cup 2020. Further, I will comply with any rules or codes of behaviour or the instructions of the Team Manager and/or the Team Coach.
5. Agree that failure to abide by any instruction, rules or codes of behaviour set by the Team Manager and/or the Team Coach could result in disciplinary action and my subsequent dismissal from Team Australia and that I could be sent home at my expense or the expense of my parent/guardian.
6. In applying for consideration for selection for Team Australia Youth World Cup 2020, I will undertake fundraising activities in support of the Australian Quarter Horse Association's involvement in Youth World Cup 2020.
7. If selected as member of Team Australia, I will be required to raise AUD\$6,500 (please see Briefing document for payment dates) which will be applied to the team's expenses in relation to its participation in Youth World Cup 2020 and that once this amount has been raised I will continue to help raise monies where possible for the benefit of all youth.
8. I agree to abide by all conditions as specified in the Briefing Document in relation to fundraising activities.
9. I hereby acknowledge that any phone calls/social media updates that I require to make will be done so only between the hours of 7pm to 7am whilst in attendance at YWC camps in Australia and whilst at the YWC in the Netherlands.
10. I hereby agree that the administration of any medications, for whatever reasons, will only be administered by the Team Manager.

PARENT/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT

I/we understand that if my/our child is selected as a riding, reserve or leadership team member of Team Australia for Youth World Cup 2020 to be held in the Netherlands that I/we will

1. Understand that the selection process is confidential and agree that I/we will not contact the selectors; Directors of the AQHA or Youth Convenor at any time either prior to or after the selection process with regards to any selection details.
2. Give consent for my/our child to participate in any or all activities related to Youth World Cup 2020 Team Australia selection activities and processes and agree to delegate my authority to the organisers of such team selection activities.
3. Give consent for my/our child, if selected, to participate in any or all activities as part of Team Australia for Youth World Cup 2020 and agree to delegate my authority to the Team Management.
4. Warrant that my/our child does not have any medical/physical condition/s which would prevent him/her from participating in any Youth World Cup related activities.
5. Give permission for the management of Team Australia Youth World Cup 2020 to authorise any necessary medical treatment for my/our child and I/we agree that we will be responsible for any costs.
6. Further authorise qualified practitioners to administer anaesthetic should this be necessary at any time.
7. Understand and agree that should my/our child be disciplined and removed from Team Australia during Youth World Cup 2020, that my/our child may be sent home and that I/we accept responsibility for any costs incurred.
8. Understand and agree that **all funds** raised by my/our child toward Youth World Cup 2020 must be forwarded to the Australian Quarter Horse Association as specified in the Briefing Document.
9. Understand that I/we will make my/our own travel and accommodation arrangements and will do so wholly and independently of Team Australia and that I/we will be self-sufficient.
10. Understand and agree that I/we will not have contact with my/our child unless authorised by the Team Manager and I/we will not interfere, attempt to influence, or deliberately disrupt the planning, execution or management of any Youth World Cup 2020 related activity.
11. I understand that the administration of any medications, for whatever reasons, for my/our child, will only be administered by the Team Manager.
12. I/we will organise insurance cover whilst participating in YWC, ensuring the policy covers equine activities.
